"The 6th Annual Mavericks Sprint-O-Rama"

- SANCTION:** Held under USA / Pacific Swimming Sanction No.: 0079
- LOCATION:** Oceana High School, 401 Paloma Avenue, Pacifica. Two parking lots; one entrance off Oceana Blvd., the other off Paloma Avenue. From I-280 take Highway 1, Pacifica exit. Follow Highway 1 south and take Paloma Avenue exit. Turn left on Paloma and cross over the freeway. Oceana pool is on the hill to your left.
- COURSE:** **Indoor**, 25 yard x 10-lane pool. Up to 7 lanes will be used for competition. Warm-up/cool-down area is available.
- TIME:** **Session A of the meet will begin at 8:30 am.** Warm ups from 7:00 am to 8:15 am for Session A. **Session B will begin one hour after Session A finishes but not before 11:00 am.** Session B warm-ups will begin immediately after Session A finishes.
- RULES:** Current USA and Pacific Swimming rules will govern the meet. Pacific Swimming warm-up procedures will be in effect. A copy of these procedures will be posted at the Clerk of Course. All coaches and deck officials must wear their USA Swimming membership cards in a visible manner. All events are timed finals. Swimmers may compete in **FOUR (4)** individual events. Swimmers aged 12 years and younger are restricted to four hours of competition. If local conditions warrant it, the Meet Referee with the concurrence of the Meet Director may require a mandatory scratch down. An immediate refund will be made for any mandatory scratch down. ***"Entry times submitted for this meet will be checked against a computer database and may be changed in accordance with Pacific Swimming Entry Time Verification Procedures."*** The meet will be **LIMITED** to the first **400 swimmers** in each session or when the meet estimated time line exceeds the Four Hour Rule per Age Group & Gender.
- RESTRICTIONS:** Smoking and the use of other tobacco products are prohibited in all parts of the pool complex and in all areas used by swimmers during the meet and during warm up periods. Sale and use of alcoholic beverages is prohibited in all areas of the meet venue. Glass containers of all kinds are strictly prohibited in the pool building. Any such container will be confiscated. **No tents are allowed on the pool deck or any other area within the pool's complex and no unauthorized vehicles may park on the lawn areas.**
- ELIGIBILITY:** Swimmers must be current members of USA-S and enter their name and registration number on the meet entry card as they are shown on their Registration Card. If this is not done, it may be difficult to match the swimmer with the registration and times database. The meet host must check all swimmer registrations against the SWIMS database, and if not found to be registered, the Meet Director shall accept the registration at the meet (a \$10 surcharge will be added to the regular registration fee). Duplicate registrations will be refunded by mail. The meet is open to all qualified swimmers. Swimmers in the "C" Division must have not met the listed "B" time standards. Swimmers in the "B" Division must have met the listed "B" time standards and have not met the listed "A" time standards. Swimmers in the "A" Division must have met the listed "A" time standards. Swimmers 19 years of age and older may participate in the 13&over division, but will not receive awards. **Disabled swimmers are welcome to attend this meet and should contact the Meet Director or Meet Referee regarding special accommodations on entry times and seeding per Pacific Swimming policy.**
- CHECK IN:** The meet will be deck seeded. Swimmers must check in at the Clerk-of-Course. Check-in for all events shall close no more than **30 minutes before** the estimated time of the start of the first heat of the event. Swimmers who do not check in will not be allowed to compete in the event.
- SCRATCHES:** **Any swimmer who has checked in for an individual event and fails to swim that event will be scratched from the meet unless the swimmer returns to the clerk of the course and repeats the check-in process for all remaining events. Failure to swim an event after re-check-in will result in being barred from the next individual event in which a swimmer is entered on that day or the next meet day, whichever is first. The penalty will not apply if the swimmer scratches the event before it is seeded, or if the Referee accepts proof that the failure was caused by illness, injury or other circumstances beyond the control of the swimmer.**
- ENTRIES:** **Option 1: Online Meet Entries:**
Enter at: <http://swimconnection.com/pc/meet/mav> to receive immediate confirmation of acceptance via email. The "billing information" email should be brought to the meet as proof of entry. Online entry requires payment by credit card using our secure site. The cost of using Online Meet Entries is \$1 per swimmer plus 5% of the total entry fees. Please note that the processing fee is a separate fee from the entry fees. Online meet entry fees are paid to Swim Connection LLC. Fees collected by the use of this system are completely voluntary. Online Meet Entry is in no way required or expected of a swimmer by Pacific Swimming. Online entries will be **accepted until Thursday**,

January 29, 2009 at 3:00 pm or when entries exceed the 400 swimmers per session limit/or a timeline in excess of the “4 Hour Rule.”

Option 2: Surface Mail Entries:

Entries must be on the ATTACHED FORM. Entries must be completely filled out including best short course time for each event. Entered times must be submitted in yards. Zone 1 North Team entries that are postmarked by midnight Monday, January 19, 2009 will be given priority acceptance. Entries must be postmarked by Monday, January 26, 2009. The entries of other Pacific Zones or LSC’s entries will not be considered until Monday, January 26, 2009. **Hand delivered entries** to Pauline Burke @ 1450 Alamo Street, Montara, CA (650-728-5790) will be accepted between 11:00 am and 3:00 pm through Thursday, January 29, 2009 if the meet timeline/number of swimmers has not been exceeded. All entries will be considered in the order that they are received. No late entries will be accepted. Except for mandatory scratches, no refunds will be given. A self-addressed stamped envelope is advisable for immediate acknowledgment of meet entry; otherwise refused entries will be mailed to team’s mailing address as a group after the last day entries are accepted. **Relays will be Deck Entered at the Clerk of Course, in each session, by an announced time. Relay cards for the medley relays are due 45 minutes before the session begins.**

ENTRY FEES: Entries that do not include applicable fees will not be accepted. \$2.25 per event, plus \$5.00 participation fee per swimmer to help cover meet expenses. Relay fee of \$7.00 per relay team entered.

MINIMUM OFFICIALS: Teams must follow Zone 1 North rules for providing officials. Each team must provide officials for each session according to the number of swimmers entered in that session, following the table below. Teams that do not provide sufficient officials must provide coaches to act in the place of officials.

AWARDS: Individual events will be awarded in the A, B, and C Divisions. Ribbons for 1st – 8th place are given to the following age groups: 6/un, 7-8, 9-10, 11-12, 13-14, 15-16 & 17-18. No awards will be given to swimmers 19 years of age and older. Standard “A” medals will be awarded to swimmers achieving **NEW** “A” times in each event regardless of place in event. A High Point award will be awarded to the top three boys & girls from each age group. The top 16 fastest swimmers in all divisions will receive points towards the High Point Award as follows: 1st place-20pts, 2nd 16pts, 3rd 14pts, 4th 13pts, 5th 12pts, 6th 11pts, 7th 10pts, 8th 9pts, 9th 8pts, 10th 7pts, 11th 6pts, 12th 5pts, 13th 4pts, 14th 3pts, 15th 2pts and 16th 1pt. Points will be tallied after each session followed by a short awards ceremony. **Relay events will not be scored but will receive awards for 1st through 3rd place.** All awards must be picked up

at the end of the meet by coaches. No awards will be mailed.
