

Bishop Swim Team
ZONE 4 SHORT COURSE INVITATIONAL MEET
June 26-28, 2009

SANCTION: Held under USA/Pacific Swimming Sanction No. **0749**

LOCATION: Bishop City Pool, 688 North Main St. Bishop, CA.

COURSE: 25 yard outdoor heated pool. Electronic Timing. Up to 7 Keifer competition lanes: 1 warm-up/cool-down lane.

TIME: *Friday Afternoon Session (18 & Under):* Begins at 5:00pm with warm-ups from 4:00 – 4:45pm. *Morning Session (10 & Under):* Begins at 8:30am Saturday and Sunday with warm-ups from 7:00 – 8:15am. *Afternoon Session (11 & Over):* Begins no earlier than noon on Saturday and Sunday with warm-ups commencing immediately following the morning session.

RULES: Current USA and Pacific Swimming rules will govern the meet. Pacific Swimming warm-up procedures will be in effect. A copy of these procedures will be posted at the Clerk-of-Course. All events are timed finals. **All swimmers ages 12 and under should complete competition within four (4) hours.** Swimmers may compete in 2 individual events on Friday and up to 5 individual events on Saturday and Sunday but cannot exceed 10 events for the meet plus relays. Swimmers entered in the 500 free and the 1000 free must supply their own counters and timers. The 500 free and the 1000 free will be swum slowest to fastest. All coaches and deck officials must wear their USA Swimming (USA-S) membership cards in a visible manner. ***Entries will be accepted until the number of splashes exceeds the estimated time line, per the Four Hour Rule, based on swimmer's age and gender.*** If local conditions warrant it the Meet Referee, with the concurrence of the Meet Director may require a mandatory scratch down to 3 events per swimmer. Immediate refunds will be made for any mandatory scratches.

RESTRICTIONS: Glass containers of all kinds, sale and use of alcoholic beverages and tobacco products are prohibited in all areas of meet venue defined as on the pool deck, in the locker rooms, in spectator seating or standing areas and in all areas used by swimmers, during the meet and during warm-up periods. Use of cell phones is prohibited in the locker rooms. No animals are allowed on the premises. The Bishop City Park does not provide camping facilities. **NO PARKING** will be allowed on the city park access road.

ELIGIBILITY: Swimmers must be current members of USA-S and enter their name and registration number on the meet entry card as they are shown on their Registration Card. If this is not done, it may be difficult to match the swimmer with the registration and times database. The meet host must check all swimmer registrations against the SWIMS database and if not found to be registered, the Meet Director shall accept the registration at the meet (a \$10 surcharge will be added to the regular registration fee). Duplicate registrations will be refunded by mail. ***Entry times submitted for this meet will be checked against a computer database and may be changed in accordance with Pacific Swimming Entry Time Verification Procedures.*** This meet is limited to the first 300 swimmers entered in each session. Swimmers 19 years of age and older may participate in 13-ovr events but will not receive awards or score points. Disabled swimmers, attached or unattached, are welcome to attend this meet and should contact the Meet Director or Meet Referee regarding special accommodations on entry times and seeding per Pacific Swimming policy.

CHECK-IN: The meet will be deck seeded. Swimmers must check in at the Clerk-of-Course. Close of check-in for all events shall be no more than 30 minutes before the estimated time of the start of the first heat of the event. Swimmers who do not check-in will not be allowed to compete in the event.

SCRATCHES: Failure to swim an event a swimmer has checked-in for will result in being scratched from the meet unless the swimmer returns to the clerk of the course and repeats the check-in process for all remaining events. Failure to swim an event after re-check-in will result in being barred from the next individual event in which a swimmer is entered on that day or the next meet day, whichever is first. There will be no penalty for not checking in

for an event, the swimmer will simply be scratched from that event.

ENTRIES: Entries must be on attached SAMMS Consolidated Entry Card. Entry Cards must be completely filled out including best short course time for each event. Entered times must be submitted in yards. "No time" entries will be accepted.

Entries must be postmarked by midnight, Monday June 15th, 2009 or hand-delivered by Thursday, June 18th, 2009 to coaching staff at the pool. No late entries will be accepted. No refunds will be made. Relay entries will be accepted at an announced time.

Optional: Online Meet Entries:

Enter at <http://swimconnection.com/pc/meet/bst> to receive immediate confirmation of acceptance via email. **No online entries after Monday, June 15, 2009.** The "billing information" email should be brought to the meet as proof of entry. Online entry requires payment by credit card using vendor's secure site. The cost of using Online Meet Entries is **\$1.00** per swimmer plus **5%** of the total entry fees. Please note that the processing fee is a separate fee from the entry fees. Online meet entry fees are paid to Swim Connection LLC. Fees collected by the use of this system are completely voluntary. Online Meet Entry is in no way required or expected of a swimmer by Pacific Swimming.

ENTRY FEES: **\$2.75** per event. **\$9.00** per relay entry. **\$5.00 per swimmer participation fee to help cover meet expenses.**

AWARDS: *Individual Ages will be awarded as:* 6 & Under, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, & 18. The 6 & Under, 7, and 8 ages will swim together in an 8 & Under age group but will be awarded separately. The 9 and 10 ages will swim together but will be awarded separately. The 11 and 12 ages will swim together as an 11-12 age group but will be awarded separately. The 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, & 18 ages will swim together as a 13-over age group but will be awarded separately. Swimmers 19 years of age and older will not receive awards. Friday evening's 18 & under events will be awarded separately as the above listed ages, but swum together by the individual seed times. Custom 'Muleshoe' plaques will be awarded for 1st and 2nd place high point in each age group.

For individual events: Medal awards will be given for 1st through 3rd place. Ribbon awards will be given for 4th through 10th place.

Age groups for relays will be: 8 & Under, 9-10, 11-12, and 13-18. These age group relays will be swum in the appropriate event number, seeded by entry time but awarded separately as the previously listed single age groups.

ADMISSION: Admission is free. Programs will be available for purchase for \$5.

HOSPITALITY/SNACKBAR: A snack bar will be available. Refreshments and snacks will be served to all Coaches, Officials and Timers.
