



Long Course BB± Swim Meet

July 13 – 15, 2007

- SANCTION:** Held under U.S.A. Swimming/Sierra Nevada Swimming Sanction #07-30
- LOCATION:** Woodland Community Swim Center, 155 N. West Street, Woodland, CA 95695. From I-5 north or south, take the West Street exit; travel 1½ miles south. The pool is on the right, next to Woodland High School.
- FACILITIES:** Outdoor heated 9-lane, 50-meter pool with locker rooms and rest areas. Heats may be run from both ends depending on the number of entries. All events are timed finals. One lane will be used as a warm-up, cool-down lane throughout the competition.
- TIMES:** **Friday:** Warm-ups will begin at 4:30 p.m. and competition will start at 5:30 p.m. **Saturday and Sunday:** Warm-ups begin at 7:30 a.m. Competition will start at 9:00 a.m. Official's meeting will begin 30 minutes prior to the start of each session.
- RULES:** Current USA-S and Sierra Nevada Swimming rules will govern the meet. Sierra Nevada warm-up procedures will be in effect and a copy of the procedures will be posted at the meet. **Swimmers are limited to five (5) events per day and ten (10) events during the meet.** Those entries in excess of five per day, and ten for the meet, will not be refunded.
- ELIGIBILITY:** All swimmers must have a current USA Swimming registration card. Swimmers who enter "**PENDING**" or "**APPLIED FOR**" must be prepared to present proof of registration or pay the registration fee at time of check-in. Registration will be verified. If a swimmer is found not to be registered at check-in, the Meet Director shall accept the registration at the meet (a \$2 surcharge will be added to the regular registration fee). Duplicate registrations will be refunded by mail. Properly registered 19-over swimmers may enter 11-18 and 13-18 age group events; however, they will not be awarded.
- ENTRIES:** **MAILED ENTRIES:** Entries must be on a SAMMS Consolidated Entry Card or facsimile. Entry cards must be completely filled out and legible; incomplete cards will not be accepted. **NO REFUNDS.** Make checks payable to **Woodland Swim Team.** Mailed entries must be postmarked by midnight Monday, July 2, 2007 and mailed to:

Additionally, entries may be hand delivered to the Woodland Swim Center between 4:00 – 7:00 p.m. until Monday July 2nd, provided the cap has not been met. The cap will be determined when the entries are received. Mailed entries, with postmarks prior to the due date, will not be accepted if received after the cap has been exceeded. Online entries are the best way to ensure you are entered in the meet. No telephone confirmations will be made.

ONLINE ENTRIES: Enter at: <http://swimconnection.com/sn/meet/wood> to receive an immediate entry confirmation of acceptance via email. The "Billing Info" e-mail should be brought to the meet as proof of entry. Online entry requires payment by credit card using a secure website. Swim Connection LLC charges a processing fee for

this service, equal to \$1.00 per swimmer plus 5% of the total Entry Fees. Please note that the processing fee is a separate fee from the Entry Fees described below. Entering online, which requires the payment of this processing fee, is completely voluntary. If you do not wish to pay the processing fee, enter the meet using a mail or hand delivered entry. Online meet entry is not required in order to enter this meet.

DECK ENTRIES: Deck entries will be accepted until the cap is reached for each session. Deck entries will be swim for time only; they will not be scored or awarded. For inquiries about deck entries, email the meet director after Saturday, July 7.

ENTRY LIMITS: The meet will be capped at the first 450 swimmers Saturday and Sunday, and the first 250 swimmers on Friday. Each swimmer is limited to competing in a maximum of five (5) individual events per day and ten (10) individual events for the meet.

SCRATCH DOWN: At the discretion of the Meet Referee in consultation with the Meet Director, swimmers may be required to scratch down. In this case, swimmers will be given a coupon for the value of the entry fee that can be redeemed or used as cash at the snack bar.

ENTRY FEES: \$2.25 per individual event for all entries (includes \$0.50 to Sierra Nevada, \$0.50 to Sierra Nevada Age Group Travel Fund, and \$0.25 to Sierra Nevada National Travel Funds) plus a \$5.00 per swimmer surcharge. Deck entries are \$2.50 plus surcharge. Make checks payable to "**Woodland Swim Team.**" Entry fees are non-refundable.

CHECK-IN: The meet will be deck seeded. Check-in will start at 4:30 p.m. on Friday and 7:30 a.m. on Saturday/Sunday. Swimmers must check-in for the first four (4) events on Friday by 5:00 p.m.; and on Saturday and Sunday by 8:30 a.m. Swimmers in later events must check-in at least 30 minutes before the estimated start time of the first heat of the event. Check-in will be located on the deck until the start of competition. Thereafter, check-in will be located in the office at the southwest corner of the facility.

AWARDS: "A" medals will be awarded to all swimmers achieving a new "A" time. BB+ flight awards: pins 1st – 3rd and double overlay ribbons from 4th – 8th. B flight awards: single ribbon 1st – 8th. Two flights will be awarded. Swimmers (except 8 & Unders) entering with a Sierra Nevada "BB" time or better in an event will be seeded in the "BB+" flight. All others will be seeded in the "B" flight. 8 & Unders swimming in starred 10 & Under events will be awarded separately; and they will be seeded into flights based on Sierra Nevada "A" times. 11-12, 13-14, 15-16 and 17-18 swimmers will be awarded separately in individual events. Awards must be picked up at the meet – they will not be mailed. It is recommended that they be picked up during the course of the day. **Deck entries will not be awarded.**

ADMISSION: Free. A three-day program will be available for \$4.00.

MISCELLANEOUS: A snack bar will be available, serving a pancake breakfast, lunch and snack food. NorCal Swim Shop and GIC Graphic Wear will be present at this event. Lunch and refreshments will be served to all working officials and coaches. Light refreshments will be served to all timers.

OFFICIAL'S DRESS:

Official attire at this meet will be white shoes, white socks, white polo shirts and navy blue pants/shorts/skirts.

MINIMUM OFFICIALS RULE:

Each team shall, by the entry deadline, provide to the meet director or designee a list of officials who have agreed to represent their team during the meet, in accordance with the following table:

One half-hour before the scheduled start of each session, the meet referee shall conduct an inventory of officials, and shall compare the number of entries against the number of officials present representing each team. Those teams who have not provided sufficient officials shall have all their swimmers treated as "time-only swimmers" in all aspects of that session.

RV PARKING:

Overnight RV Parking is allowed in the Woodland High School student parking lot. See "Location" above for directions to the student parking lot. No services are provided. Due to construction on the high school gym, direct access from the student parking lot to the pool facility may not be available.

RESTRICTIONS:

Smoking and the use of other tobacco products are prohibited in all areas of the meet venue. The sale and use of alcoholic beverages is prohibited in all areas of meet venue. No pets are allowed. Excessive volume of sound equipment will not be tolerated. All tarps need to be removed from the grass areas at the conclusion of each day's competition (EZ Ups can stay up if they are fastened to the ground, but all ground covers must be off the grass). **NO PERSONAL SHADE STRUCTURES ARE ALLOWED ON DECK.** No overnight parking is allowed at the Community Swim Center, except as provided above.
